Abelia grandiflora	Attractive shrub with mauve red foliage and pink flowers. Prunes well and commonly used for hedging.
Abelia grandiflora Francis Mason	Attractive shrub with golden foliage and pink flowers. Prunes well and commonly used for hedging.
Abelia Snow Showers	An attractive compact growing shrub with creamy variegated foliage. White flowers are produced in spring. Great for containers, low hedges or borders. Best in full sun. Hardy. Evergreen. 80cm in height.
Abelia Snowtime	A dwarf Abelia with lovely white flowers which appear early Autumn. Very hardy, full or partial shade. Can be trimmed for a low hedge. 1m x 1m
Acacia melanoxylon	Blackwood. Australian native prized for beautifully marked timber. Forms a dense round headed evergreen tree, with racemes of pale yellow flowers in winter and early spring. Useful for shelter and/or timber. 30 x 15m.
Acaena inermis Purpurea	NZ Native. Purple Bidi bid. Forms a low grow groundcover ideal for rockery or small garden. Evergreen. 1m wide.
Acer Bloodgood	A very good blood red color. One of the best reds. Turning orange and red in autumn. 3m. Deciduous.
Acer Burgundy	Japanese Maple. Vase shaped crown 4m x 4m. Prefers sheltered position. Crimson foliage in autumn. Deciduous.
Acer Burundy Lace	Deeply divided and serrated fringed leaves with burundy wine. Small upright tree
Acer capillaries	Vase shaped tree with unusual bark, green foliage turning red in autumn, hardy. Grows 6m .
Acer Fireglow	Japanese Maple. Upright growth habit & plum red foliage. 4m x 3m. Deciduous.
Acer Katsura	New growth is orange yellow fading to green and turning bright yellow in autumn. 3m. Deciduous.
Acer Lion Heart	A smaller semi weeping form that has really nice red leaves in spring and summer, turning orange in autumn
Acer negundo Flamingo	North American Maple with green foliage bordered silvery cream. Young growth tinted pink. Very hardy. 6m x 4m
Acer negundo Kellys Gold	Golden form of the North American Maple. Rich golden foliage throughout the growing season. Hardy. 3m.
Acer negundo Variegata	North American Maple with green foliage bordered with yellow margins. Hardy. 6 x 4m
Acer palmatifidum	A lovely green weeping maple that keeps its color throughout the year. Turns orange and red in the autumn. Deciduous. 1.5m.
Acer palmatum	Japanese Maple. Deciduous, bushy headed tree or shrub. Height and spread 6m or more. Palmate, deeply lobed, mid green leaves turn brilliant orange, red or yellow in autumn.
Acer palmatum Beni Maiko	Fiery red or scarlet leaves in spring fading into a pinkish red with slight green undertone. In Autumn, an edging of deep pink red appears in the leaves margins spreading into the centre until the whole leaf is a blaze.
Acer palmatum Beni Schichihenge	Fresh green narrow lobed leaves bordered with white. The white is overlaid with warm pinkish salmon. Soft tones of orange red in autumn.
Acer palmatum Bloodgood	Japanese Maple. Vase shaped tree with red foliage. 4m x 3m.
Acer palmatum Chiosho	Dwarf growing form with brilliant shrimp red spring foliage, bronzing in summer. Bright orange red in autumn.
Acer palmatum Dissectum	Weeping Maple. Graceful branches, first horizontal then weeping to the ground, clothed with rich green, delicate, finely cut, almost fern-like leaves. Dwarf growth habit, slow maturing. A top landscape plant. 1 x 1.5m
Acer palmatum dissectum Crimson Queen	The weeping Crimson Queen Maple retains deep red purple colouring throughout the summer. Autumn tones are fiery scarlet. 1m. Deciduous.
Acer palmatum Dissectum Purpurea	Japanese Maple. Delicate deep purple leaves. Slow growing but worth the effort. Excellent small feature tree. Prefers sheltered position. 2-3m. Deciduous.
Acer palmatum dissectum Seiryu	Upright Lace Leaf Maple. Upright growth habit with branches arising at steep angles to slowly form a broad outline, intricately dissected bright green foliage clothing gracefully pendulous branches. Autumn colors soft yellow to gold, with orange and red tints. 3 x 2.5m
Acer palmatum dissectum Tamukeyama	A wonderful cascading maple, crimson red in spring turning dark red as the season progresses. Deciduous. 1.5m.

Acer palmatum Katsura	This delightful form is striking in spring. The leaves are pale yellow orange the margins shade into brighter orange. Turning light to yellow green as the season progresses. Autumn colours are bright yellow and orange.
Acer palmatum Mikawa Ya Tsubusa	Dwarf compact form with long lime green leaves. Dense growth. Wine and gold shades in autumn.
Acer palmatum Okagami	Star shaped leaves emerge as purplish red and very quickly turn almost black. Vigorous
Acer palmatum Omurayama	An outstanding pendulous form. This one has long cascading green leaves in summer and change to a reddish gold in autumn.
Acer palmatum Osakazuki	Japanese Maple. Forms a medium size tree, fairly slow growing, with larger leaves that turn brilliant scarlet in autumn. Deciduous. 2.5m.
Acer palmatum Red Emperor	Attractive maple tree with soft red foliage from spring to autumn. Requires wind shelter, 4m.
Acer palmatum Red Pygmy	Very narrow leaves look delicate and lacy. Good red foliage. Small upright tree.
Acer palmatum Roseo Marginata	A green or bluish green variegated leaf with strong white margins. The white is overlaid with pink orange, a distinct colour that becomes orange brown in summer.
Acer platanoides	Norway Maple. Vigorous deciduous spreading tree eventually to 18m x 10m. Large broad sharply lobed bright green leaves that turn yellow or orange in autumn.
Acer psuedoplatanus Variegata	Sycamore. Strong growing maple with multicolour foliage. 8m x 6m
Acuba crotonoides Gold Strike	Large glossy leaves spotted green and gold. Grows 1.5 to 2m. Full sun or semi shade. Hardy.
Adeandra fragrans	Dwarf dense twiggy shrub. Pink flowers in spring and summer. Foliage strongly scented like aniseed. Full sun, well drained soil. 60cm.
Adeandra uniflora	China Flower. Low growing dense twiggy shrub, china white flowers backed with pale pink. Flowers all year, mostly in spring. Full sun well drained soil. 60cm -1m.
Agapanthus Dwarf Blue	Dwarf agapanthus. Narrow fleshy leaves with deep blue pom pom flower heads on short stems in summer. Very popular. 60cm. Full sun or semi shade.
Agapanthus orientalis	Common agapanthus. 80% flower blue. 20% flower white. Ideal for difficult areas, dry banks. 80cm.

Anamanthele lessoniana	Gossamer Grass. An excellent landscaping grass, forming large clumps of graceful, flowering stems and foliage, producing a light feathery effect. Coppery tinged foliage. For best color, grow in full sun. Drought and wind hardy. 80cm x 80cm.
Andromeda nana	Unusual compact groundcover / shrub, with grey green foliage and small pink lily-of-the-valley like flowers on short stems in spring. Full sun, average conditions. Good rockery plant.
